An Adult Community Since 1975


At the June 1<sup>st</sup> Board of Directors meeting the board unanimously voted to open the community pool following CDC and Palm Beach County Guidelines. We are asking for everyone's cooperation to ensure the health and safety of the entire community. The community pool will open on Monday, June 8<sup>th</sup> by reservation. Following are hours and guidelines for usage of the pool at this time.

## **GUIDELINES FOR REOPENING OF THE POOL**

- Social distancing must be followed: 6 feet from each other.
  Persons who do not cohabitate shall maintain a distance of 6 feet from each other.
- 2. The Face Coverings (FC) requirements apply to all facilities and amenities. Cloth or surgical type Face Coverings (storebought or homemade) must be worn except when in the pool.
- 3. Guest Policy To reduce exposure to members of our community,
  - Guests are prohibited.
  - Guests are anyone who is not a REGISTERED PERMANENT resident or an Owner.
  - Children are prohibited

#### 4. Restrooms:

a. Restrooms at the pool are open. The Shower Rooms are CLOSED until further notice.

#### 5. Pool Rules

a. Pools open hours - see below by reservation ONLY.

Open - 9:00 A.M to 10:00 A.M

Open - 10:30 A.M to 11:30 A.M.


Open - 12:00 P.M. to 1:00 P.M.

Open - 1:30 P.M. to 2:30 P.M

Monday through Friday, Closed on Weekends!

Spa is closed at this time.

- b. CDC guidelines MUST be followed at all times.
- c. Pool facilities be limited to residents and registered residents only.
- d. Maximum of 10 people in the pool area.
- e. Pool chairs will be removed from pool deck
- f. Half-hour cleaning slots between appointments.
- g. Call the office to make a scheduled appointment to be put on a list. Monday thru Friday. Reservations must be made 24 hours in advance. Monday reservations shall be made by Friday at 3:00 PM.
- h. Residents are responsible for bringing their own hand sanitizer.
- i. Spa will remain closed until further notice.
- i. Swimmers should minimize contact with pool surfaces.
- k. Staff that is authorized to manage the Community Pool shall ensure compliance with all guidelines and requirements set forth in this Order. Such compliance may be accomplished by any reasonable means, including, but not limited to, periodic spot checks, video or other electronic monitoring.

- In the event that repeated violations occur, staff authorized to manage the Community Pool, shall take corrective action, including, but not limited to, closing the Community Pool
- After the 2<sup>nd</sup> offense during any one-reservation period, regarding any of the above-mentioned policies, the Community Pool will be closed for the remaining reservation time period!

## 6. Pool Access

- a. To make a reservation, please call the office. Reservations may only be made 24 hours in advance. Monday reservations shall be made by Friday by 3:00 PM. Only one reservation per day per resident. You may only make a reservation for yourself or your significant other. No reservations will be accepted for a third party.
- b. Check in will be 10 minutes prior to your reservation at the east gate near the pool parking lot. Gate will be locked promptly on the hour and the half hour. Unfortunately, if you are late, you will have forfeited your reservation.
- c. 10 reservations per time slot will be allowed when the pool is open.
- d. Residents must exit the pool area from the west gate of the pool ONLY.
- e. Cindy will check in the reserved owners during the 1<sup>st</sup> 10 minutes of each time slot.
- f. Residents can NOT open the gate for additional persons to enter the pool area.
- g. Spot checks will be done by the management team via the camera and personal inspection during each time-period.
- h. At the end of each time-period, residents will leave through the west pool gate.
- i. The entire pool area will be closed down in between time-periods for cleaning of all areas.
- j. After the 2<sup>nd</sup> offense regarding any of the above-mentioned policies the Community Pool may be closed.
- k. We will continue to monitor the situation and hopefully conditions will change. We appreciate the community, patience, cooperation and support in these difficult times. As always the health and safety of the community is our primary concern.

Check in will be 10 minutes prior to your reservation at the East gate near pool parking lot.
